3. BHI – CYCLE Technical Assistance

Here is what you can expect from BHI – CYCLE technical assistance:

a. Learning Activities

BHI – CYCLE will be a virtual-first learning collaborative, meaning we will offer regular learning sessions online, including one mandatory monthly webinar (BHI – CYCLE Commons) and one optional monthly webinar (Peer Office Hour). Additionally, we invite all team members to attend an in person site visit. In addition to attending live webinars with expert perspectives and peer problem solving, we will be sharing a curated library of resources to support teams during their program projects. Additional optional learning opportunities such as CQC's Model for Improvement online course will be made available to BHI – CYCLE participants.

b. Program Resources

Starting this spring, you'll start receiving regular BHI – CYCLE newsletters (the BHI – CYCLE Connect) which will feature upcoming events, program resources, and updates to our program website.
